April Meeting Minutes Approval – Geoff Bibo

- Lenny Comeras moved and Mike O’Callaghan seconded a motion to approve the January minutes. The motion carried.

Treasurer’s Report – Fred Duy

- Fred reported that the expenses we had in the first quarter were from the Winter Parties.
- We have filed our taxes and have received our first distribution from OVTA.
- Currently we have over \$101,000 in the bank.
- Also, there was discussion/questioning by Terry Finneran in regards to the budget but decided that they take it off line since it appeared that it was an understanding issue by Terry in regards to the format.

Grant Committee – Jane McMeekin

- The committee has only received one request in the first quarter, and has approved this request for the Champions Summer Clinic in the amount of \$3,000. We are awaiting the SafePlay and Background check approvals for the individuals working as volunteers for that clinic.
- One possible explanation for the reduction in applications is the switch to our online application. She encouraged Board members to go to the site (https://ustamidwest.formstack.com/forms/gcta_grant_application) to see the application.
- Jane will be asking Scott and John to repost information about grants on our social media sites and GCTA.net.
- Scott suggested providing a completed application as a sample.
- Jane pointed out that our grants are not designed for individuals or specific teams, but rather for community efforts that would benefit a broad group.
- The committee is expecting applications from Buddy Up and Wolfe Park.

Columbus Recreation and Parks – Char Barnes

Char reported that they are struggling to find staff to work the Yout summer camps and lessons. Staff must be 18 or over. At this time she has one tennis instructor under contract. This coach will be able to cover two of the camps (Whetstone, June 6-10 & Wolfe Park, July 11-15). Any help that Board members can give to identify potential hires would be appreciated since there is a high interest in the camps. Char will provide us with a job description and a link to information about the tennis program.

Jake Diefenthaler is continuing to schedule courts for GCTA use. Contact him as soon as possible if you are going to need courts from CR & P.

Adult programming is starting soon. Bucky Walters and Chris Althouse will be teaching lessons. The Adult Doubles Leagues will begin next month on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. CR & P added a third week day for the doubles league due to the high interest following last year. Details can be found on the CR & P tennis page.

Women’s League – Lori Brown

- Lori expressed gratitude to the efforts of Transition Team in dealing with the loss of our Executive Director.
- Lori reported that the 4,000 Member preseason gifts (grip wraps) have been delivered and look great. Men’s & Women’s chair will be contacting Club Representatives to facilitate distribution.
- The Women’s Board is in the midst of reviewing preliminary rosters.
 - Currently the Women have 189 teams. Northam Park has 17, Scioto & Swim & Racquet have 14 each. The largest levels are 3.0 Career (36) and 3.5 Career (32). The 2.5 Daytime level has 15 teams, a record high number.
 - Happy to report the return of teams from Jewish Community Center, Wolfe Park, Upper Arlington High School, and New Albany High School.
 - Thanks to Char Barnes and Jake Diefenthaler for help with reserving the city’s courts.
 - Scheduling begins the week of May 2. Matches begin week of May 23.
- An updated Team Captain handout has been posted to the Forms/Downloadable Forms on Tenniscores. Also posted in Downloadable Forms are the 2022 Rules. Few changes in the rules from 2021, just a bit of tinkering and refining.

- The Winter Parties were very successful. Thanks to the organizers, Tina Gray, Julie Wiltberger Burton, and Julie Caton for their efforts. Each of the parties were full with wait lists.

Men's League – Bill Curry

- Bill also expressed gratitude to the efforts of Transition Team in dealing with the loss of our Executive Director.
- Men's League is also in the process of collecting preliminary rosters. Currently they are showing an increase of 9 (12%) teams for 2022, interestingly at the lower skill levels of play.
- After making a couple of changes in the 45+ Level, several teams decided to move to Gold. So there was no loss in the # of teams. We are also seeing some growth in the upper levels which is good to see.
- The Men's Board is entering ratings for every player this year.

 - Matches begin May 21
 - Regular season ends (roughly) week of August 11
 - Playoffs begin August 15
 - Champ of Champs – Labor Day Weekend

Junior Team Tennis – Brittany Smolewski

- JTT league will run like last year with the local league being separate from the district tournament.
 - Teams no longer have to play the local league, teams can register themselves for the tournament. This policy resulted in a loss of teams participating.
 - We will be adding two more singles to the match line up for JTT, so matches are back how they were pre-Covid with 4 singles and 2 double
 - May 2 Coaches' Zoom meeting
 - May 24th team commitments are due
 - June 3rd is first match, will run for six consecutive Fridays
- Over the last two years between Covid and the change to the district tournament we have lost a handful of programs, hoping to get some of them back this year

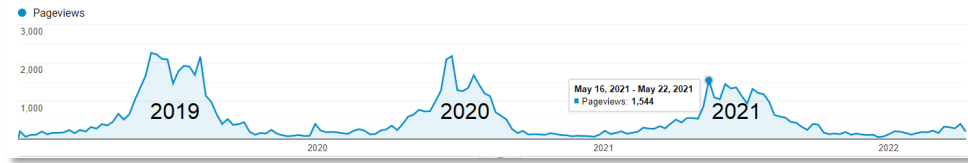

GCTA Web Site Usage

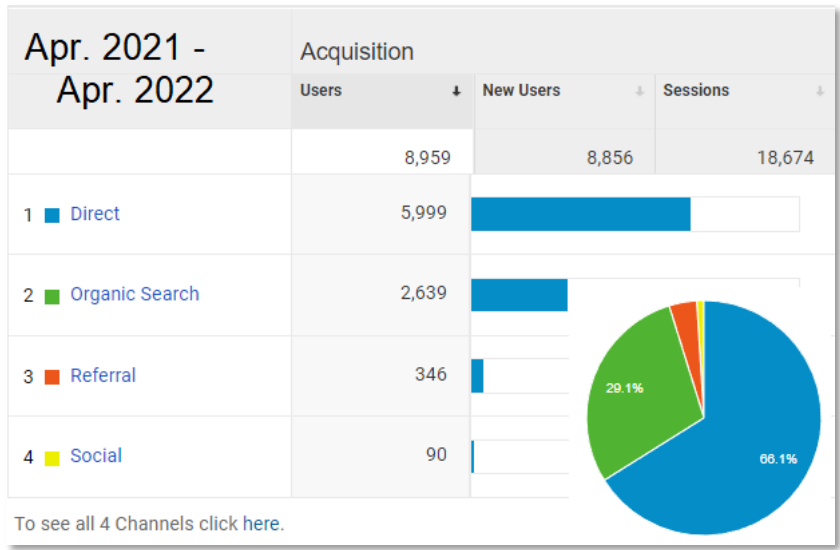
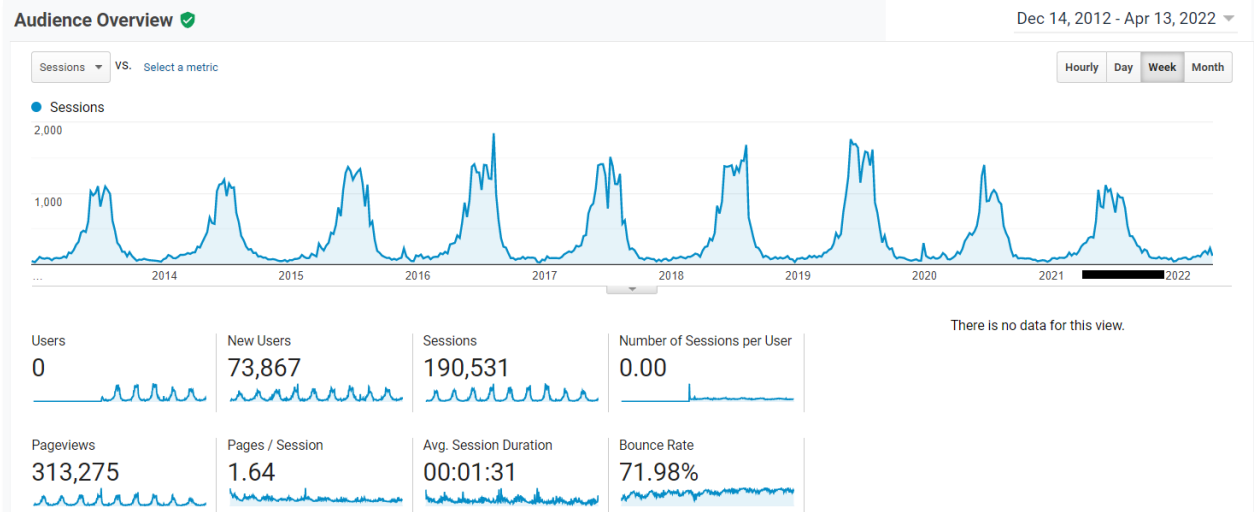

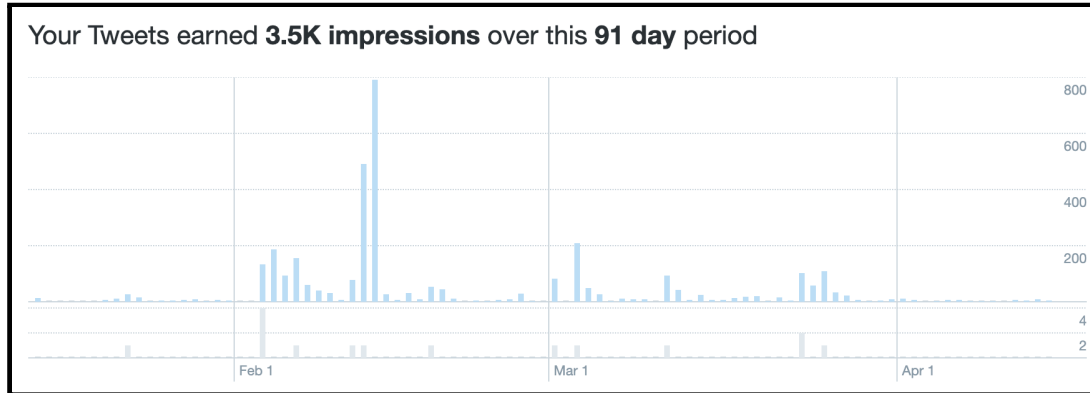
